### How Do You Say "Efficiency"?

When it comes to talking about energy efficiency, heating and air conditioning systems have a language all their own...



- ✓ If you're referring to furnaces and boilers, look for "annual fuel utilization efficiency," or AFUE.
- ✓ For room air conditioners, it's "energy efficiency ratio," or EER.
- ✓ For central air conditioners and heat pump cooling, check "seasonal energy efficiency ratio," or SEER.
- ✓ For heat pump heating, look for "heating seasonal performance factor," or HSPF.

**Regardless of the acronym, a higher number means a more efficient system.**
